2 question screening is reflected in the signs and symptoms (sadness/hopelessness/decreased self esteem and loss of interest/involvement in activities/self care)

Abuse:

Domestic abuse part of the abuse problem: Abuse assessment screening questions

May use a paper and pencil tool

% of clients that scored positive on abuse assessment screening

Child abuse part of the abuse problem:

Substantiated report of child maltreatment
Open to child protective services or alternative response
% Referred to child protection services by PHN

Neglect:

Immunizations not up to date
Well child care not up to date
Dental care not up to date
Special health care needs not met (specialist appointments)
Substantiated report of child neglect
Open to child protective services or alternative response
