Item #7	Miscellaneous	<p>Kathy asked in behalf of Olmsted County PHS internal documentation committee about consistently of use, across agencies, of the Modifier for the Growth and Development problem for preemies with LBW, where adjusted age equivalent is used, there is no evidence of delays, there is a positive growth pattern, and no screening concerns.</p> <p>The sign & symptom that is unclear to the nurses is “abnormal weight/height/head circumference in relation to growth/age standards” – what standards are agencies going by to make their decision? Do some designate it is an Actual Problem since the infant is below the norm. Or, Potential Problem because of risk factors associated with being a preemie, and that an age-adjusted growth chart is used as a growth/age standard?</p> <p>Add as an item on the July MOSUG agenda.</p> <p>Linda indicated that because of possible shut-down of State services they may not be attending the 7/18 MOSUG meeting.</p>
